
**Bending the curve**

This bold initiative is making a significant impact. The number of people newly diagnosed with HIV has declined by 50% since 2005. As of 2019, New York State has 15,000 people living with HIV. Since 2014, when STI and HIV testing was made confidential, new diagnoses have been reduced by almost every large metropolitan area. Last year, 24,000 New Yorkers were diagnosed with HIV. 


