Vision

Optimal HIV/AIDS care and treatment for all.

Mission

Provide leadership and resources to assure access to and retention in high quality, integrated care, and treatment services for vulnerable people with HIV and their families.





CARES Act Funding for RWHAP

- 4/15: Awarded \$90 million to 581 RWHAP recipients across the country
 - Prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19 for RWHAP clients
 - Provides flexibility to meet evolving needs for people with HIV related to COVID-19
- Reporting Requirements
 - Monthly COVID-19 Data Report (CDR)
 - ✓ First submission due June 15, 2020, and then on a monthly basis thereafter
 - COVID-19 Allocations and Expenditures Reports

RWHAP Part	Total Funding
Part A – Cities/Counties	\$25.8 million
Part B – States/Territories	\$24.5 million
Part C – Early Intervention Services and Capacity Development Program Grants	\$30 million
Part D - Services for Women, Infants, Children, and Youth	\$5 million





COVID-19 Claims Reimbursement Portal

- HRSA designated to develop COVID-19 Claims
 Reimbursement to Health Care Providers and Facilities
 for Testing and Treatment of the Uninsured Program
 - Available to Health care providers who have provided COVID-19 testing and/or treatment for uninsured individuals on or after February 4, 2020
 - Request claims reimbursement electronically through the COVID-19 Uninsured Program Portal
 - Reimbursed, generally at Medicare rates for testing and treating uninsured individuals for COVID-19

- April 22 Program Details launch
- April 27 Sign up period begins for the program
- April 29 On Demand training starts
- May 6 Begin submitting claims electronically
- May 18 Begin receiving reimbursement

 - RWHAP Part B States/Territories Supplemental Grant Program extended by 11 days
 - RWHAP Part C Capacity Development Program extended by 28 days
 - FY 2021 RWHAP Part C EISEGA NOFO (HRSA-21-060, HRSA-21-061, and HRSA-21-062) are postponed
 - Quality Improvement Solutions for Sustained Epidemic Control Project (QISSEC) extended by 21 days
- Data Reporting
 - RWHAP Services Report (RSR) reporting deadline extended by 30 days
