to prevent people who do not have HIV
from getting the HIV virus, by taking one
pill every day as prescribed.

READY, SET, PrEP IS PART OF ENDING THE HIV EPIDEMIC: A PLAN FOR AMERICA

The initiative's goal is to reduce the number of new HIV infections in the U.S. by:

75% IN 5 YEARS

90% BY 2030

The Ready, Set, PrEP Program makes PrEP medication available at no cost for people who qualify.

HOW CAN I ENROLL IN THE READY, SET, PrEP PROGRAM?

To receive PrEP medication through the Ready, Set, PrEP program, you must:

- ✓ **Test negative for HIV**
- ✓ **Have a valid prescription from your healthcare provider**
- ✓ **Not have insurance that covers prescription drugs**
