Optimal HIV/AIDS care and treatment for all.


Mission

Provide leadership and resources to assure access to and retention in high quality, integrated care, and treatment services for vulnerable people with HIV and their families.






Race/Ethnicity Distribution of All RWHAP Clients and RWHAP Clients Receiving Services in Select Jurisdictions, 2017



Viral Suppression among Hispanic/Latino RWHAP Clients Receiving Services in Florida and in Miami, FL, 2017




HRSA EHE Listening Sessions – Key Themes

- plan reac PMHCP, INNON
 - Addressing mental health, substance use, transportation, incarceration, and homelessness is critical to reach people not in care
 - Leveraging community strengths by hiring community health workers, peer navigators, peer specialists, etc.
 - Planning for EHE needs to include community-based organizations, people with HIV, and new partners
 - Supporting training for clinic staff to ensure that culturally responsive and supportive experiences happen for clients (for care and PrEP)
 - Addressing stigma, distrust, and criminalization laws
